STATEMENTS

Majority Chief Whip, (Hon. Benjamin Leitore): Thank you Mr. Speaker, I stand to raise a concern that there is a big number of pending statements which have not been answered. To mention but a few, Sarima land issue, quarterly reports sought by hon. Loldepe and statement on bursaries disbursement. So, we seek your indulgence on when these statements should be responded to because members are eagerly waiting for the responses.

Temporary Speaker, (Hon. Shadrack Lesoipa): Thank you hon. Member, I direct quarterly reports to be tabled on Thursday next week and for the Sarima report, is the chair around? What is it hon. Leitore?

Majority Chief Whip, (Hon. Leitore): Mr. Speaker, the chair is not present as he is on a trip abroad but any other member of the committee can give the response or shade some light on any information that is available.

Temporary Speaker, (Hon. Lesoipa): Is there any member of the committee present? Hon. Leajore.

MCA Lodokejek Ward, (Hon. Leshoomo): Thank you hon. Speaker, we all know that we have several businesses and I do not know what the work of the House Business Committee is, as there are a lot of pending issues and many bills that require public participation.
