**Deputy Speaker**, (hon. Lanyasunya): Hon. Members you did not exhaust discussion of the Governor's speech, hon Leshoomo.

**MCA Lodojek ward**, (hon. Jerius Leshoomo): Thank you Mr. Speaker, I also stand to congratulate H.E the Governor for giving us his first address to this County Assembly of Samburu. H.E has just high lightened the major activities undertaken by his government under the years and we really thank the governor for addressing this assembly on these critical activities that were undertaken. The governor has just high lightened all activities that were undertaken by the departments in all sectors; from education, health, lands resources and roads. We have also seen in the address that all major projects that were undertaken in the last two years were high lightened. We are also aware that there are some activities and projects that were budgeted for, over the last two years but were not implemented as per the address of the governor and nothing has been said in the address to see what happened or where the money went and in my opinion, there is a gap in the address of the governor because we were not told what happened to those activities that were not undertaken. And what is the future and how can we undertake those activities that were not undertaken in the last two years. The address tackled the issues that were in our two year budget. **Majority Chief Whip**, (hon. Benjamin Leitore): Thank you Mr. Speaker, I did point out yesterday my appreciation to the Governor and I would like to thank the governor for the second time but I also did point out loopholes in his address like the issue of women has not been addressed and it is two years down the line and there is nothing the county government of Samburu has done for women of Samburu. Linda for pointing out how the County Government should incorporate the issues that pertain to women in the forthcoming budget. The governor should also have indicated as we know that there is a serious corruption in this county government despite the fact that good things have been done by the government, but there are problems like saying that there are **14** playgrounds completed, a problem that we all know is pending before this House, is actually a decline, so it is not the truth because as the playground in my ward is incomplete likewise in Kisima, Loosuk and other wards. So saying that the **14** playgrounds have been completed is not true. And I think in the governor's address full year he will point out those weaknesses that were performed by his
