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**Honorable Speaker,**

The Hon. Shadrak Lesoipa , MCA, (Suguta Marmar Ward Ward) requested for a statement (no. 24) on the 10<sup>th</sup> Sep. 2015 from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Public Works, Water and Sanitation concerning the status of the Lchingei Loikurkur road construction.

**Honorable Speaker,**

The Committee conveyed the request for statement to the CEC member for the department of Public Works, Water and Sanitation.

**Honorable Speaker,**

On behalf of the Committee, I wish to report the communication received from the CEC member.

1. **THAT**, the contractor on Lchingei- Loikurkur road started work on schedule and progressed well. Later on when the drift was to be constructed the dozing machine that was to prepare the site by removing the top unsuitable soil broke down and had to be repaired. There was also the issue of resistance from the community to allow the contractor to use the hard core.
  
2. **THAT**, after collecting a portion of the required hard core, the community wanted to be monetarily compensated. This led to a standoff between the contractor and the community. The department had to intervene and the issue was resolved amicably and thus part of the material remained on site for some time as work could not start without all the materials required. The road is now 100% complete, usable and the contractor is now fully paid.

3. **THAT**, the department is closely supervising all ongoing projects, and will be sensitizing the communities time before such projects embark in order to counter such problems in the future.

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**Honorable Speaker,**

The Hon. Raisy Letura , MCA, (Suguta Marmar Ward Ward) requested for a statement (no. 23) on the 10<sup>th</sup> Sep. 2015 from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Public Works, Water and Sanitation concerning the status of several Roads in Ndoto Ward.

**Honorable Speaker,**

The Committee conveyed the request for statement to the CEC member for the department of Public Works, Water and Sanitation.

**Honorable Speaker,**

On behalf of the Committee, I wish to report the communication received from the CEC member.

**4. THAT, on the Lesirikan-Kelesua Road;**

After grading a portion of the road, it was found that the soils are very loose. For this reason 1.5 km of the road is to be graveled in this financial year to ensure smooth ride. This road had 32m of 900mm diameter culverts. The remaining amount in the contract sum from dozing and 38m of 900mm culverts will be used to gravel sections of the road. All this is in the contract document.

**5. THAT, on the Junction-Illaut-Seren Road;**

After grading a portion of the road, it was found that the soils are very loose. For this reason 1.75 km of the road is to be graveled in this financial year and 21m of 900mm diameter culverts installed to ensure easy accessibility.

**6. THAT, on the Junction-Illaut- Arsim Road;**

After grading a portion of the road, it was found that the soils are very loose. For this reason 2.5 km of the road is to be graveled in this financial year and 14m of 900mm diameter culverts installed to ensure travelling comfort.
