# Report on the employment of ambulance Drivers by the County Government

## **STATEMENTS**

Chair for Medical Services, Public Health and Sanitation, (hon. John Lemulugo): Mr. Speaker Sir, on 14<sup>th</sup> October 2015, Hon. Jerias Leshoomo, MCA Lodokejek Ward, sought a statement from the department of Medical Services, Public Health and Sanitation concerning the employment of ambulance drivers. Pursuant to Standing Order 191(5), the statement was committed to the Committee on Medical Services, Public Health and Sanitation.

The committee conveyed the same to the department through a letter dated 15<sup>th</sup> October, 2015 with reference number SBU/CA/CK/MSPS/VOL.I/004 in which the department replied through a letter received on 21<sup>st</sup> October, 2015 reference number MOH/SC/CAC/15. But the committee found that the response was not satisfactory.

The committee had several meetings and found it necessary to write a report on the same. In order to go to the root of the matter, the committee invited the concerned officers including:

- 5. Mr. Meshack Kariuki Paying Cashier.
- 6. All Ambulance drivers.

The committee has tabled a report on the same and a notice of motion for the adoption of the report has been given. I hope that the report will answer the statement sought by the hon. Leshoomo and adoption of the report will help us correct the anomalies. Thank you.
