**MCA Ang'ata Nanyokie Ward**, (hon. Paul Leshimpiro): Thank you Mr. Speaker. Pursuant to Standing Order No. 45 (2) (c), I hereby request for a statement from the Leader of Majority regarding the continued stay and use of County resources (vehicle) by Ms. Mary Kanyaman, former CEC for Education.

Mr. Speaker Sir, section 42 of the County Government Act 2012, states that, 'when a general election is held for a county government, the outgoing CEC shall remain in office until a new Committee is constituted after the election. The constitution of a new Executive Committee after an election under section 1 shall be finalized within 21 days of the Members of the County Assembly.

Mr. Speaker, the 21 days have elapsed and the County Assembly disapproved the nomination of Ms. Mary Kanyaman as a member of the Executive Committee. A new CEC member for the department of Education have been approved by the Assembly and taken through an oath. Despite this, Ms. Mary Kanyaman is still using the vehicle as the CEC Member for Education and the legally appointed CEC for Education is left without the vehicle.

In view of this, the Leader of Majority should inquire into and report on:

1. The reason for continued use of office of the CEC member for Education by unapproved Ms. Mary Kanyaman Ekai while the approved CEC is walking.
